HAVING ACQUIRED the favourable opinion of the Academic Senate in its meeting of 18.02.2019, regarding the organization and activation of Specializing Masters, among which the Specializing Master of II Level "DESIGN FOR DEVELOPMENT ARCHITECTURE, URBAN PLANNING AND HERITAGE IN THE GLOBAL SOUTH".

#### **HEREBY DECREES**

That the "DESIGN FOR DEVELOPMENT ARCHITECTURE, URBAN PLANNING AND HERITAGE IN THE GLOBAL SOUTH" Specializing Master of II Level is set up and activated for the year 2019/2020.

## ARTICLE 1 Master features

At the Department of Architecture and Urban Studies, the "DESIGN FOR DEVELOPMENT ARCHITECTURE, URBAN PLANNING AND HERITAGE IN THE GLOBAL SOUTH" Specializing Master of II Level is set up and activated;

The administrative seat of the Specializing Master is provided by POLIEDRA, the reference School is the School of Architecture, Urban Planning and Construction Engineering. The Head of the Specializing Master is prof. Camillo Magni. The Deputy director is professor Paola Bellaviti.

The Specializing Master Programme Commission is made up by professors of Politecnico di Milano: Gabriele Pasqui, Agostino Petrillo, Camillo Magni, Maria Cristina Giambruno, Laura Montedoro, Paola Bellaviti, and Francesco Chiodelli, Gran Sasso Science Institute (L'Aquila).

# **ARTICLE 2** Educational objective and job opportunities

The impacts of globalisation on cities and regions are creating huge socio-spatial imbalances, environmental emergencies and complex urban management problems, particularly in the regions of the Global South and in countries with emerging economies. Operating in these places requires innovative professional skills to be expressly developed to be able to face the challenges of inclusive, sustainable urban development and seize the opportunities offered by transformations to improve physical and social contexts ("make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable" - United Nations 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, Goal 11). The Master's in Design for Development has been devised to meet these demands in the firm belief that the design disciplines can play a leading role in these new urbanisation processes. Indeed, there is ever growing demand from all sides for design experts capable of navigating the challenging contexts of the Global South by bringing skills and expertise that focus on the governability and quality of urban and regional development. With this in mind, the Master's programme sets out to train professionals with an international outlook capable of tackling the most difficult challenges posed by contemporary urban development with skill and creativity, based on an approach that blends research, design and innovation. These

new professionals will be offered a broad overview of design at a variety of scales, in which architecture, planning and heritage protection are all aspects of the same approach to design which aims to develop effective strategies for defending and developing the regions in which they operate in environmental and social terms. The aim of the programme is to produce professionals/consultants in the area of development-related spatial issues who can seek employment at the supranational, national or local scale, whether in the public, private or third sector.

The Master's programme offers a high level of technical specialisation for students wishing to find employment with: - multilateral organisations, and international agencies and networks which promote programmes for sustainable urban development at the global scale (for example UN- Habitat, UNESCO, the FAO, UNICEF, the Cities Alliance, the World Bank, the World Urban Campaign, etc.); - institutions, research centres, companies, foundations and other philanthropic organisations which promote/fund/develop programmes and partnerships between national governments and local administrative bodies in countries of the Global South (for example Agenzia Italiana per la Cooperazione allo Sviluppo, Fondazione Eni Enrico Mattei; Fondazione Cariplo, Fondazione Lerici, the Aga Khan Foundation, the International Institute for Environment and Development, Istituto Oikos, etc.); - non-governmental organisations (NGOs) operating in field of international cooperation, involved in projects dedicated to the integrated development of local areas and communities (for example Emergency, Coopi, Oxfam, ActionAid, Africa 70, Cesvi, Cospe, Celim, etc.); - nonprofit associations, networks and professional studios dedicated to promoting design for spatial and environmental justice and the right to housing (for example Architecture Sans Frontières International and its respective national branches, Ingegneri Senza Frontiere, Architecture for Humanity, Emergency Architecture and Human Rights, Urban Planning for Democracy, Urban Think Thank, TAMassociati, etc.). In order to maximise such opportunities, participants in the Master's programme will complete an internship at organisations that satisfy these profiles.

## The course will be held in English.

# ARTICLE 3 Content and organization of training activities

The Specializing Master will start in September 2019 and will end at end in September 2020.

The Master's programme is promoted by DAStU (the Politecnico's Department of Architecture and Urban Studies), which is acknowledged as one of the most prestigious research centres in the field of architecture and urban planning in Italy and abroad. The programme constitutes one of the Department's actions in the field of international research and higher education dedicated to inclusive, sustainable urban development in the cities and regions of the Global South. The syllabus will be taught by a team of DAStU teachers and researchers specialising in the themes and fields of application of the course, with the participation of prestigious teachers from other universities and world-renowned experts from research centres, multilateral organisations, and national and international NGOs operating in the contexts of the Global South. The Master's programme takes an original approach to teaching and learning, founded on: a) tight integration of theory and practical application through a learning-by-doing approach; b) a global perspective on understanding and interpreting urban phenomena; c) a specific design-oriented approach at the various scales, integrating architecture, planning and heritage protection; d) ample space dedicated to practical experience "on the ground" through a five- week international design workshop; e) an internship at an organisation operating in the Global South, designed to offer a potential route into employment in the field.

The Master's programme has a duration of 1,500 hours in total, consisting of lectures, exercises, visits, workshops and individual study, and an internship of 300 hours. The Master's programme is organised into five different modules: MODULE A \_THEORY AND TOOLS / 12 ECTS \_MODULE B \_DESIGN WORKSHOPS / 12 ECTS \_ MODULE C \_ INTERNATIONAL DESIGN WORKSHOP / 16 ECTS \_ MODULE D \_INTERNSHIP / 12 ECTS \_ MODULE E \_FINAL THESIS / 8 ECTS

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# ARTICLE 4 Requirements for participation

The University Master's Degree is restricted to graduated students (Master of Science) in Architecture, Engineering, Urban Planning, Design or other related scientific disciplines. For foreign applicants the equivalent degrees, issued by foreign Universities, will be considered. The maximum number of students admitted is 25.

The selection is made by the Commission.

## ARTICLE 5 Formal fulfilment

The admission application must be presented in one day from the day after the date of this Decree and within May, 31st, 2019.

### \* Italian/foreign citizens with educational qualifications obtained in Italy

- Self-certification concerning personal identity (surname and name, date and place of birth, nationality and residence)
- copy of the identity document
- copy of the Diploma Supplement or photocopy of the laurea qualification and certificate with the list of exams taken for graduate students of the Old Educational System

### \* Italian/U.E. citizens with a qualification obtained abroad

- Self-certification concerning personal identity (surname and name, date and place of birth, nationality and residence)
- copy of the identity document
- Photocopy of the academic qualification obtained, with a certificate showing the scores obtained in each exam or Diploma Supplement (<u>upon enrolment</u>, the on-site Value Declaration issued by the Italian Representation abroad competent for the territory or certification issued by the Enic/Naric Centres)

The admission application must show the declaration. ## \* Non-U.E. citizens with a qualification obtained abroad

Non-EU foreign citizens must submit to the Institution:

- copy of qualification in original language and the related translation into Italian/English/French or Spanish
- **copy of transcripts** with the list of exams in original language and the related translation into Italian/English/French or Spanish or **Diploma Supplement**
- copy of valid passport
- Curriculum Vitae

At least 30 days before the closing date for registration, as indicated in this article.

The Institution sends all the documents listed above for the evaluation of the qualifications, for the purposes of participation in the Specializing Master, to Politecnico di Milano, Corporate and Continuing Education

Master and Specializing Programmes, within the deadline of this call, according to the provisions of the MIUR/MAE note "Procedures for access, stay and registration of visa applicant students for higher education programmes in Italy for the academic year 2018/19"

The Corporate and Continuing Education communicates the acceptance of the student and the outcome of the access tests, where required, to the competent Representations, for completion of the documentation related to the qualification, required for the issue of the Entry Visa.

After confirmation of acceptance by the University, the candidates submit their qualification to the Diplomatic Representation, for the required consular acts.

Students admitted to the Master must submit to the MIP the application for enrolment on the specific dedicated form, with stamp duty, it can be downloaded from the University website at the page <a href="https://www.polimi.it/corsi/documentazione/">https://www.polimi.it/corsi/documentazione/</a> with copy of an identity document (passport in case of non-EU citizens). The achievement of the academic qualification in Italy can be self-certified by filling out dedicated box on the enrolment application, while the qualification obtained abroad must be documented by presenting an **on-site value declaration** issued by the Italian Representation abroad competent for the territory (Italian Embassy or Italian Consulate) on letterhead with its original stamp; **or certification issued by the Enic/Naric Centres.** 

Non-EU citizens, in addition to documents mentioned above must submit a copy of the residence permit.

# ARTICLE 6 Qualification and recognitions

### **CERTIFICATION ISSUED**

At the end of the programme, after passing the final exam, the Specializing Master diploma of II level in "DESIGN FOR DEVELOPMENT. Architecture, Planning and Heritage in the Global South" will be issued, in English.

To obtain the admission to the final exam of the Master, students must submit to Politecnico di Milano - within 30 days before the exam date - a specific request on legal paper. The request form can be downloaded from the University website, on the page <a href="https://www.polimi.it/corsi/documentazione/">https://www.polimi.it/corsi/documentazione/</a>

### **OBLIGATIONS OF STUDENTS**

Attendance to the activities of the Master is compulsory for at least 75% of the programme activities. The renunciation to study must be submitted in writing. The training period cannot be suspended for any reason. It is not possible to enrol, at the same time, in a Specializing Master and in another study programme activated by an Italian University.

#### METHOD OF VERIFICATION

Tests will be carried out, as well as it will be required to prepare and discuss exercises and cases, plus a final exam. The final exam will consist in presentation and discussion of final work.

The cost of the Specializing Master is  $9.500,00 \in$ , to be paid as below:
