

SCOTT LLOYD

Scott Lloyd ist Architekt und Stadtforscher und lebt in Zürich. Er war in der Schweiz, in China, Australien und Südafrika in der Architektur, Forschung, Veröffentlichung sowie in kuratorischen Projekten tätig. Er ist der Herausgeber von "Infrastructure as Architecture", einem Werk, das Infrastruktur unter soziologischen, ökologischen, ökonomischen, politischen und räumlich-baulichen Gesichtspunkten beleuchtet, sowie auch Herausgeber des Journals der Architekturbiennale in Beijing. Er konzipierte und kuratierte "Spaces of Flow" am Chinesischen Nationalmuseum, eine unabhängige Studie zur Erforschung und Kommunikation neuer Themen der schnellen Urbanisierung. Er besitzt einen Master-Abschluss in Architektur der ETH Zürich, wo er sich seit 2012 zusammen mit dem Urban Think-Tank in der Designforschung über grundlegende Architektur und die Global City engagiert. Mit dieser Gruppe war er der koordinierende Architekt für ein Forschungs- und Implementierungsprojekt für alternative Wohnformen und Aufwertungsmethoden in Cape Town, Südafrika. Das Projekt wurde 2017 mit dem UN-Habitat-Preis für "Best Practice in the Built Environment" ausgezeichnet. Darüber hinaus ist er für die Konzeption und Leitung von Workshops für Design und Bau, Mapping und Szenarienplanung mit neuen digitalen Planungs- und Analysetools - zusammen mit den zuständigen Forschungslehrstuhlinhabern der ETH Zürich - sowie für den Evaluierungsrahmen des Projekts verantwortlich.

Er ist Vorstandsmitglied der Architekturforschungsgruppe TEN. Seine Werke wurden oft veröffentlicht und bei der Architekturbiennale Venedig 2010 und 2012 präsentiert. Er wurde als Gastvortragender für alternative Architektur- und Stadtplanungsmethoden von unterschiedlichen Plattformen eingeladen, unter anderem von der ETHZ, der Union Internationale des Architectes, von UN-Habitat, dem International Forum on Urbanism, dem Deutschen Architekturmuseum und dem African Centre for Cities. Vor Kurzem war er auch in "REVER LE FUTUR : Les villes du futur" zu sehen, einem Dokumentarfilm über Städte der Zukunft für das französische Staatsfernsehen sowie für ARTE.
