

PROFILE

Antonio Longo is a full Professor in the Department of Architecture and Urban Studies (DASTU) and Coordinator of the MSc in Landscape Architecture, Land Landscape Heritage at the School AUIC in the Politecnico di Milano. He graduated in Architecture and has been a Professional Architect and Urbanist since 1992. Currently he teaches, conducts research and practices design focusing on urban planning, urban design and landscape design.

Born in Milan in 1966, he graduated from a Classical High School in 1985. He enrolled in the faculty of Architecture in 1985, combining his studies with internship activities at national and international Practices (A.Cendron, Pentagram Design London, B.Secchi). Between 1992 and 1993 he carried out civil service at the welfare office of the Municipality of Rodengo Salarno (BS). He graduated with honors at the Politecnico di Milano in December 1992 with a thesis on the open spaces of the "diffused city" (supervisor Patrizia Gabellini), then until 1995 he collaborated with the Studio of Bernardo Secchi and Paola Viganò (plans and projects in Italy and in Flanders 1992-1995).

In 1995 he won a scholarship for international specialization and moved to Germany at the IRPUD, Institut für Raumplanung at the University of Dortmund, for a one year of research fellowship (1995/96) focusing on territorial strategies (IBA Ruhr) and the German tradition of landscape and garden design and planning. In 1996-1999 he attended a PhD in Territorial Planning (joint faculties of Milan, Turin and Venice), obtaining the title of PhD in 2000 with a thesis on the relationship between urban and landscape planning and the practice of drawing and representation.

In his work he combines design practice with research activity: between 1996 and 1998 he directed the Planning Office of the city of Seregno (MB) developing a land use plan, a structural masterplan and various urban transformation projects and landscape projects subsequently implemented. Later he carried out an intense design and research activity both as a freelancer and at the DIAP (now DASTU) of the Politecnico di Milano. Between 1997 and 1998 he collaborated, as a board member, in the management of a large historical monumental complex including its park (Villa Contarini in Piazzola sul Brenta) where he promoted the recovery and reuse of the Villa and the Park and contributed to the management plan.

In 2007 he founded Ubi Studio srl, a company formalized in May 2008 together with Alessandro Ali, where he carries out scientific consultancy activities within the limits defined by the university framework and the University rules.

As research fellow, from 2002 to 2006, he combined studies on the design of open spaces and landscape with a specific interest in the forms of drawing both in research and in teaching, teaching as adjunct professor (professore a contratto) from 2000 to 2008 "Technique and design of the Plan" at the Bachelor of Urbanism.

Between 2001 and 2003 he was adjunct professor of *Landscape Architecture in the Urban Planning Laboratory* at the Faculty of Architecture of Ascoli Piceno, University of Camerino.

In 2008 he won the position of Assistant Professor in Urban and Territorial Planning and Design and focused his teaching activity on urban planning studios/workshops.

In 2014 he obtained National Scientific Qualification as Associate professor. Winner of a public competition in 2014, he has subsequently become Associated Professor at DASTU of the Politecnico di Milano.

In 2021 he obtained National Scientific Qualification as Full Professor.

He carries out teaching activities by coordinating and participating in Integrated Design Studios as part of the Bachelor of Science of Architecture, the MSc in Urban Planning and Policy Design.

In 2017 he participated in the conception and the accreditation process of the new master's degree course in *Landscape Architecture_ Land Landscape Heritage* which he coordinated for the three-year period 2018-2020, and has been re-elected for the three-year period 2021-2023.

He teaches at the double degree program of the Joint School of Design promoted by the Politecnico di Milano and by Xi'an Jiaotong University (XJTU) (Planning in Historical Context Studio 2020, 2021).

He is a lecturer for the Master in Global Health promoted by the State University of Milan (SDG module 2020, 2021).

He is Member of the PHD teaching committee in Urban Planning Design and Policy.

His research themes concern the role of the design of open spaces and landscape in the reorganization and regeneration of contemporary territories, the transdisciplinary composition and the forms of the project in the processes of regulation, transformation and land and landscape management and design, the relationship between landscape and infrastructures, the role of parks and water in the urban planning of cities.

The landscape is considered as a transdisciplinary field capable of bringing together - in a humanistic as opposed to a deterministic way - different knowledge, skills and traditions - often distinct and separate, sometimes conflicting - on issues relevant to the city and the territory. In this sense, the relationship between representation, and landscape are part of a common research path. This transdisciplinary approach has led him to concentrate the research activity more on original experiences with a strong link to the territorial and applicative dimension, characterized by mixed academic, institutional and associative partnerships.

The coordination and direction of the MSc in Landscape Architecture has also rapidly assumed a strongly international character (by origin and interests of the students, and has become an important field of experimentation in the collaboration of skills and knowledge. This activity includes the participations and the contents dealt with at the recent IFLA and Eclas conferences, and the delegation to Uniscape.

The activities where his role is scientific manager and designer at DASTU are developed both in the context of consulting and applied research agreements with Public Administrations and private individuals and in the context of co-financed research contracts (Provinces, Regions, European Union) or private foundations (in particular the Cariplo Foundation). The research mainly developed in consolidated partnerships and as a result of competitive procedures where he was the promoter and manager.

The design themes deal with large-scale strategic design (strategic schemes for Turin, Pedemontana Lombarda motorway, Esino river valley, North Milan) to landscape design on a local scale (municipal plans of Castelli Caleppio, Cinisello Balsamo, San Donato Milanese, Jesi), to the ecological and systemic analysis and design of complex landscapes (open spaces of Martesana and Villaresi, of the Middle Olona, ecological network of the Lambro River, gardens of the Milanese Metropolitan City, Lombard farmhouses and mountain pastures), and also include consultancy for the design and management of urban landscape areas (implementation of the Grande Parco Forlanini park, Ponte Lambro, Parco Lambro sectors as implementation of the ecological network of Lambro Milanese, ERSF leader; project for the water meadows ('marcite') of the city of Norcia (PG).

The contents of the research is documented in volumes, essays and articles in which documentation of the project action and reflection are closely related

Since 2015 he has promoted the collaboration of landscape and territory issued between the Politecnico and the University of Milan through the Bioregione project (Grant from Fondazione Cariplo), the European Open Agri project (UA Urban Innovative Actions _ Lead Partner of the Municipality of Milan). This line of collaboration has also fed and directed the formation of the new degree course in Landscape Architecture through a specific didactic and research collaboration agreement. In this context, he currently participates in the promotion of the observatory on agroecology and the AIDA association (Italian Agroecology Association) launched at the Università Statale initiated by Prof. Stefano Bocchi, in the master in Global Health at the same University.

He is a member of scientific and technical committees relating to environmental and landscape issues: Aida management committee _ Italian Association of Agroecology; Technical Scientific Committee of the Ca'Granda Heritage Foundation; member of the Consorzio Poliedra scientific council of the Politecnico di Milano (DASTU delegation until 2021); member of the scientific committee of the ForestaMi project (nominated by the rector of the Politecnico di Milano).

Between 2011 and 2016 he was a member of the Technical Scientific Council for the revision of the Territory Governance Plan of the Municipality of Milan. Here he worked on the design of ecological networks and the environmental system on a metropolitan scale.

The research and research by design activity has been developed, particularly in the last decade, in close relationship with current urban themes and issues of the city of Milan, actively promoting public initiatives related to the construction of the environmental system and of the parks and public spaces of the city. Many of the research activities conducted in the last decade have touched and promoted these objectives by interpreting the objectives of societal engagement and the third mission of the university.

COURSES AND STUDIOS HELD AS ASSISTANT AND ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR (2008-2021)

The teaching activity is developed through four main themes strongly connected with the research lines:

- the setting of specific skills in **drawing and communication**, in particular for Bachelor's students in Urban Planning. The teaching method has been refined through "processes" that connect different techniques and tools of representation and communication (from GIS data management to communication and post-production, rendering and layout)

- **Urban planning and design in contemporary cities and regions**, considered as a set of consolidated techniques and practical knowledge and, at the same time, as a field of research by design. The design/teaching activity offered to the students is based on the critical construction of the context, reinterpretation of case studies and projects.
