## PROFILE

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M. Antonella Bruzzese (Genoa, Italy 1969), architect and urban planner, is currently Associate professor in urban design and planning at the Politecnico di Milano. She graduated in Architecture with honours and right of publication ("dignità di stampa") in December 1995 at the University of Genoa. In 2001 she obtained the degree of Doctor of Philosophy in Urban Planning, Spatial and Environmental Planning at the Politecnico di Milano with the thesis *Images in action. City-Image-making in processes of urban transformations*. After the Ph.D. she started to collaborate with Politecnico di Milano with research grants about the role and shapes of the "urban project". In parallel, she continued her activities as a practitioner: from 1993 to 2016; she worked as a founder member of Gruppo A12, a collective of architects who experienced various ways in designing spaces – architectural projects, urban interventions, art installations, and research. Throughout her professional carrier, she also worked as a consultant and urban planner. And from 2016 to 2021, she has been appointed Town planning councilor (assessore municipale) for the District 3 of the Municipality of Milan, constantly feeding her research activities through direct experience in urban design, planning, and management.

At the Politecnico di Milano she teaches *Urban planning* at the Bachelor's Degree Course in Architectural Design and *Urban Design* at the Master's Degree Course in Urban Planning and Policy Design. From 2003 to 2013, she taught Urban Design at NABA, the New Academy of Fine Arts of Milan, and Spatial Planning at the Catholic Faculty in Brescia and various design workshops. She has been invited to give lessons and seminars in several schools and research (University Westminster, GSSI, Scuola di dottorato di Napoli, Domus Academy, Politecnico di Bari, Università di Trieste, Roma, Università di Evora, Brandenburg University of Technology Cottbus). Since 2013 she is a member of the Ph.D. board of professors - Urban Planning, Design, Policy of the Politecnico di Milano. From 2024 she is the director of the first and second level postgraduate course M-US-T Master Temporay uses.

Through teaching, research, practice, and consulting activities, she works on urban design and transformation strategies to investigate the place-making processes. More specifically, her research interests are about the relationships between the project of the physical space (urban design) and urban policies, participatory and communication strategies, temporary interventions, with a specific interest in public space.

Her research interests concern three main topics on which she has been working through different tools and occasions:

- **Contemporary urban design and its innovative tools at different scales:** on this topic, she had post-doc fellowships from DASU, Politecnico di Milano, has been the co-chair of a session of the annual SIU conference (Atelier: Urban design, la via italiana); has organized public seminars (*Conversations on composition*, with A. Longo); has coordinated design workshops at national and international level (*Miaw 2010, Brasilia 50+50 2011*, the *Research by design workshops* within the UPDP Ph.D. program). She also took part in design teams (Call for ideas of Politecnico di Milano for transformation scenarios of Bovisa) and in international research proposals exploring open design innovative forms. Another field of design exploration concerns the design of temporary uses, developed with the direction of the first international Master temporary uses.
- **The relationship between design, uses, and quality of the living space, with particular attention to public space, urban regeneration, and participatory processes.** Concerning these topics, she has been chairing the track *Regenerating Urbanity* at the international EURA Conference, Milan 2022; was part of the research team of the National Research PRIN 2007 *The "public city" as a design laboratory. The production of guidelines for the sustainable redevelopment of urban peripheries*; she wrote essays about public space; promoted the project *ASC! Attivare Spazi Comuni*, under the framework of the social responsibility program of Politecnico di Milano, Polisocial, developing a teaching program in which students interact with local associations.
- **The nexus between urban transformations and creative industries, regarding the new forms of production:** about that, she has been the chair of a Special Session of the annual Regional Study Association in Piacenza about *new manufacturing, innovative workplaces, and urban space* (2015); organized seminars (*I luoghi della creatività a Milano*, Triennale di Milano 2013) and participated in conferences (*Urban Creative Poles*, Cottbus 2013; *Creative and Cultural Industries. Economic development and Urban regeneration*, Rome, 2015). She tutored master's and PhD thesis on the topic and wrote articles and books (*Addensamenti creativi, trasformazioni urbane e Fuorisalone*, Maggioli, 2015, *Servizi commerciali e produzioni creative. Sei itinerari nella Milano che cambia*, Bruno Mondadori, Milano 2014, with L.Tamini, *Creative production and urban regeneration in Milan*, 2017).

She worked as a curator of exhibitions (*Brasilia. A utopia come true. 1960-2011*, Triennale di Milano 2010, *Borders*, Urban Center Milano, 2014, proposal for the Italian Pavilion at the Biennale of Venice 2015). Between 2010 and 2017 she has been a member of the scientific editorial board of the journal *Territorio* and between 2017 and 2022 has been co-director of the book series "Innovation and urban space" by Bruno Mondadori publisher.

Besides research and teaching activities, she gained various work experiences in urban planning and urban design, facing the project and management of urban transformation with a wide variety of scales and operational tools.

She participated - with different responsibilities - in different works: the elaboration of calls for ideas and of “expressions of interest regarding the redevelopment and acquisition of industrial sites held by Enel” (2016-19); active listening aiming at the establishment of guidelines for the transformation of Milanese railway yards (2013-14); definition of planning tools (studies for the Castelli Calepio PGT, 2012-13 and San Donato Milanese PGT, 2007); development of innovative forms of urban planning (master plan for the areas of Gasometri Bovisa, Milan 2006 and military areas in Piacenza 2009) and complex programs (PRUSST, Contratti di Quartiere II). She also coordinated participatory design workshops (Laboratorio Quartieri, Progetto San Donato 2004-06).

She is also a founding member of the *Gruppo A12* - a collective of architects active from 1993 to 2016 – with whom she has realized in Italy and abroad architectural and urban projects and installations in public space, taking part in exhibitions and biennials (among others: Art Biennale, Venice 2003, Busan Biennale in Korea 2010, Istanbul Biennial 2009, PS1 New York, Kröller Müller Museum, Otterlo, Triennale di Milano 2014). *gruppo A12*'s projects have been published in various catalogues, magazines and art and architecture books ([www.gruppoa12.org](http://www.gruppoa12.org)).

From 2016 to 2021, she has been appointed Town planning District Councilor (Assessore municipale a Urbanistica, Verde e Spazio pubblico) at the City of Milano - District 3. In that role, she had the opportunity to follow and run several interventions in public space involving participatory processes and deepen the knowledge in managing urban transformation processes.

## RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

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### *Main research topics*

Her research focuses mainly on urban design and urban transformation strategies, intending to investigate place-making processes. More specifically, her research interests are about the relationships between the project of the physical space (urban design) and urban policies, participatory and communication strategies, temporary interventions, with a specific interest for public space and neighborhood scale.

She has always approached research as a complex set of activities, including social interaction and research-by-design; in these years, she developed three main research directions, mainly fed by work experiences and the reflection upon them.

The first line of research concerns **contemporary urban design and its innovative forms at different scales**. The topic has been faced with research and design activities, both in teaching and work experiences. In this regard, she proposed and ran a parallel session within the National Conference of the Italian Society of Town Planners (SIU Milan 2014, Atelier: Urban design, la via italiana with L.Montedoro); curated seminars with representatives of different disciplines (the cycle of seminars *Conversation on composition*, with A. Longo, 2012); had two Post-Doc Fellowships at the DASTU Politecnico di Milano on the topic. She organized and participated in national and international workshops (workshop *PF\_01, Brasilia 50+50 2011, Mlaw 2010*, and has been responsible for *Research by design workshops* within the UPDP Ph.D. program for several years). She also participated in a design team that worked for the Politecnico di Milano Call for ideas for Bovisa transformation scenarios (project *Ricomposizioni selettive*, 2016). She faced the issue also through the very practice of the project, intended as a means of research: she participated in the project team for the Masterplan for the military areas of Piacenza or Santa Barbara in Future program); worked at the definition of planning tools to test the relationship between planning and design (PGT Castelli Caleppio, S.Donato).

The second area of interest and work regards the **relationship between space and uses, the habitable space quality, and the ways of its production, activation, or transformation. With attention to the public space, the regeneration of the existing environment, and the participatory processes**. In the research aimed at studying Brasilia or the public city of Milan or the public spaces, she has always combined the analysis of the morphological and spatial characteristics of urban environments at different scales with the observation of the people's practices, reflecting upon the efficacy and the effectiveness of various forms of project. Two international publications with Fisker J., Chiappini L. Pugalis L. (*Enabling Urban Alternatives. Crises, Contestation, and Cooperation*, Palgrave Mcmillian, 2019 and *The Production of Alternative Urban Spaces: An International Dialogue*, Routledge, 2019) explore these issues. About these topics, she was part of the research team of the National Research PRIN 2007 *The "public city" as a design laboratory. The production of guidelines for the sustainable redevelopment of urban peripheries*; she wrote essays about public spaces; in the framework of Didattica sul campo, Polisocial – the social responsibility program of Politecnico di Milano - she promoted *ASC! Attivare Spazi Comuni*, a teaching program in which students interact with the local associations to prepare their design proposals. Has participated, as unit coordinator, to the proposal for the National Research PRIN 2016 *Pubblica-mente* (national coordinator L.Basso) and, as a team member, to the proposal for the PRIN 2020 *Experience-Based Healthy Urban Design. Requirements and indicators for the "HEathy urbAn realMs"* (national coordinator S.Capolongo). During her experience in the public administration in Milan, as a Town councilor, she experimented different ways of participation, co-design, collaborative design, and managing (Participatory Budgeting or Community gardens in District 3). She could also participate in the elaboration of several urban projects for public space, anticipated by the so-called "tactical" interventions designed with citizens (bid "Piazze Aperte")

These two issues have recently developed in a particular interest in designing and planning the **neighborhood scale** or what she called the "**intermediate**" **scale**. She has recently written about this topic in the article "Scala intermedia / abitare in prossimità. Note su due ambiti di lavoro necessari" (SIU 2021) and reflected on it with the organization of the series of public conferences at Polimi, "Neighborhood plans for the **15-Minute City**" 2021 and "The 15-minute city? Roots, practices, and critical perspectives" (2022) and coordinating the track "Regenerating Urbanity" in international conference of Eura, Milan 2022.

Finally, a further field of investigation regards the **nexus between urban transformations and cultural and creative industries, with reference to the new form of production and the so-called socio-cultural hybrid spaces**. She studied both Italian cases (participating in research both about the relationship between creative production and commercial services in Milan and about the role of art and design schools in the construction of the "creative city") and foreigner cases (like the *Beyond project* in Utrecht described in one of her essays). About that, as a member of the DASTU "New productions" research Hub, she has been the chair of the Regional Study Association Special Session in Piacenza *New manufacturing, innovative workplaces, and urban space* (2015). She organized seminars (*I luoghi della creatività a Milano*, Triennale di Milano 2013); participated in conferences (*Urban Creative Poles* in Cottbus 2013; *Creative and cultural Industries. Economic development and Urban regeneration*, Rome 2015) and wrote articles and books (*Addensamenti creativi, trasformazioni urbane e Fuorisalone*, 2015; *Servizi commerciali e produzioni creative. Sei itinerari nella Milano che cambia*, 2014, with L.Tamini, *Creative production and urban regeneration in Milan* 2017, *Dismissioni, usi temporanei, eventi e rigenerazione urbana. She has been also a tutor of Master's degree thesis and Ph.D. thesis around these topics and tutor of the multidisciplinary project (*Caps – CreA(c)tive Places*, Alta Scuola Politecnica 2014-15), consultant for the preparation of proposals for local policies (sub-project *Nuovi "cantieri" per la creatività urbana* developed by a Dastu working group and promoted by the City of Piacenza).
