EDUCATION

Lavinia Dondi graduated with a **Master's Degree in Architecture** at the School of Civil Architecture of Politecnico di Milano Bovisa in 2010 and became a licensed Architect in 2011. She then obtained her **Ph.D. in Interior Architecture and Exhibition Design** at the Department of Architecture and Urban Studies (DASU) of the Politecnico di Milano in 2015. An Erasmus experience at Kingston University in London fueled the Ph.D. research.

Lavinia Dondi has been conducting research activities since 2011, first at the Department of Architecture (DPA) and then at DASU. She has been a research fellow since 2017 (**5 research fellowships**), and from the end of 2018 until the end of 2021, she has been part of the research group Territorial Fragilities, linked to the DASU Project of Excellence. Over the years, she has participated in **2 research groups** of national relevance and worked on drafting research proposals for funding calls.

Since 2018, Lavinia Dondi has participated as a speaker in **15 international and national conferences** and as a speaker or discussant in **14 international and national seminars**. Since 2019, she has curated and organised, sometimes together with other colleagues, **5 seminars**, with national and international guests, at the Politecnico di Milano and a roundtable at Università IUAV di Venezia linked to an international conference.

topics

The research activity has focused primarily on *landscape design* as an interdisciplinary tool to interpret and transform places in a cross-scalar way. Within the architectural and landscape regeneration framework, the *open space* assumes a pivotal role both for its value as a resizeable and adaptive-reusable in-between area – to design transitions from architectural interiors to urban scenarios or from urban scenarios to peri-urban countryside – and for its environmental and ecological value as an area in which to rebalance natural elements – mainly vegetation and water – and improve biodiversity.

TEACHING

Lavinia Dondi has been an **adjunct professor** at the School of Architecture Urban Planning Construction Engineering (AUC) of Politecnico di Milano since the **2016-2017** academic year and has conducted tutoring and **teaching support activities**, first at the School of Civil Architecture and then at the AUC School, since **2011-2012**.

Since 2014, she has been invited to give some lectures within design studios and participate in teaching seminars as a discussant, promoting them also within her studio activities.

Since the 2013-2014 academic year, she has supervised **10 master's thesis** as a co-supervisor; since the 2017-2018 academic year, she has been the supervisor of **5 bachelor's thesis** and, in 2022, of **1 master's thesis**.

Since 2014, she has participated as a tutor in **5 international and national**

workshops promoted by Politecnico di Milano, some of which took place in foreign countries.

topics

The common topic of the teaching activities is the regeneration of the built environment: the specific focus is on urban spaces, sometimes involving public or semi-public ground floors surrounding them. A network of people-oriented spatial connections is even more crucial when the work concerns the redefinition of heterogeneous and conflicting parts of the city. The core of the *urban design studio* is the relationship between urban landscape dynamics and site-specific design, fed by human-scale issues and environmental issues affecting open space and related to vegetation, water, and microclimate.

PUBLISHING

Lavinia Dondi's academic publishing includes **2 authored book** and **1 edited-by book, 10 book chapters, 7 journal papers**, one of which is under peer-reviewed process and 5 of which are in "classe a"/Scopus-indexed journals, and **8 papers proceedings**, one of which is upcoming and most of them subject to double-blind peer review. Since 2022 she has been a *reviewer* within the Editorial Team of the international scientific society Architecture Media Politics Society (AMPS).

topics

The works testify to two research tracks. On the one hand, a track directly linked to the Ph.D. thesis and fueled mainly in the years after the dissertation: it deals with the neighborhood spaces for culture or social activities, focusing on the spatial ideas linked to inclusiveness, permeability towards the city, and interactions between uses. On the other hand, a more recent track deals with *landscapes architecture and open spaces*, involving territorial or design scales and urban, peri-urban or rural scenarios, investigated in their spatial proximity relationships, fragilities, and care perspectives connected to landscape design as a tool for knowledge, regeneration, and resilience.

PRACTICE

Lavinia Dondi (member of the Ordine degli Architetti, Pianificatori, Paesaggisti e Conservatori since **2015**) has carried out professional activities as a licensed architect in the field of interior spaces, with **3 completed works**, but mostly in the field of open spaces, with **2 commissioned studies** - in collaboration with Politecnico di Milano (DAStU) and Consorzio di Bonifica Est Ticino Villoresi - and competition activities.

Private foundations and public institutions funded the two commissioned studies. They represented the opportunity to investigate, through *research-by-design* experiences, the regeneration of peri-urban and rural open space involving waterlines, even minor ones. Through a *landscape design approach*, the actions were cross-scalar, from a territorial to a design scale concerning artifacts, infrastructures or leisure places, and constantly fueled by environmental and ecological issues, with in-depth studies on the vegetation to be enhanced.

Some of the research-by-design solutions that *Lavinia Dondi* has collaborated on have been exhibited at the Politecnico di Milano. In 2020, with the reBel-la group, she won the **first prize** in the ReLive 2020 design competition for scholars. The winning project was also selected to represent the Politecnico di Milano at *The festival of New European Bauhaus*, in Brussels.

abstract

The research topic is the neighborhood centres for culture, or the socio-cultural spaces that spot contemporary cities representing essential tools to oversee urban scenarios, mainly where social problems arise. In particular, the focus is on the neighborhood library and its sequence of equipped places surrounding to polarise cultural and social activities whose articulated programs reflects the complexity of contemporary phenomena. Firstly, the investigation – limited to the European scenario – explores the current meanings of the spaces for culture: a network of active workshops in which multiple identities and urban communities coexist. Secondly, the research highlights some essential historical European experiences that testify to the fruitful relationship between the rise of innovative cultural and social issues and the consequent spatial solutions provided from time to time. A basic premise of the work was analyzing the network of cultural spaces linked to neighborhood libraries within specific districts of four European cities at the forefront of the topic (London, Barcelona, Berlin, and Paris). The architectural investigation underlines spatial devices related to indoor or outdoor areas that strengthen a marked permeability to the surrounding urban places and a renewed relationship of proximity between scheduled activities (training labs, performances, or exhibitions) and spontaneous sharing or sociability situations. In architectural terms, the main result is the persistence of almost rigidly defined spaces related to specific activities – *rooms* – and simultaneously the growing development of halls or open space typology in which weak-edge places for multiple uses coexist – *squares*. Thus, the architecture idea emerging from the analyzed solutions reveals a desire to design *landscapes* moving between interiors – *interno* – and urban spaces – *intorno*. Additionally, they completely redefine the relationship between places without functional purposes, assumed gradually as the core and expanded over time, and bounded areas for specific uses.

goals and specific research activity

The main research goal is the Ecomuseum institution at Isola Pescatori - one of the islands of the Maggiore Lake - as a landscape and environmental regeneration strategy for the island territory as a whole. The study assumes the historical fishing activity and its relative uses as the essential ground for a reactivation perspective aiming at enhancing mainly biodiversity and landscape values and slowing down the tourism dynamics, which are currently aggressive. More specifically, basic premises are: the Lombardy and Piedmont ecomuseum investigation, to in-depth study networks, spacial and environmental connections, and design devices to enjoy landscape specificities; and the online map and contents definition, to disseminate the new Ecomuseum institution and trigger participatory dynamics involving the few inhabitants of the island. The project's final goals are the adaptive reuse of a small building as the Ecomuseum core - involving local architects and engineers - and the identification of the island network of peculiar places through site-specific design devices.

goals and specific research activity

The research involves peri-urban territories, focusing on their complex weakening and fragmentation processes, sometimes investigated together with environmental and hydraulic imbalances linked to waterlines. The aim is to identify possible reconnection strategies concerning the edge between urban and rural scenarios to be reimagined mainly through the architectural redefinition of open spaces and, sometimes, collective ground floors and, where present, the regeneration of water lines. An inclusive, resilient, and biodiverse connective fabric must extend beyond the edge space, involving peri-urban landscapes in their entirety and complexity. The critical reinterpretation of the Milanese area of the San Cristoforo disused railway yard and the design solution for Tor Bella Monaca in Rome, in addition to the investigated European case studies, represent two applications of analytical and design strategies matured during the research path.

goals and specific research activity

The regeneration project for the Mongue settlement is primarily fuelled by interdisciplinary analytical investigations concerning the site potential and issues, followed by the identification of the new Ecological Park protection areas. Preliminary activities, such as fieldwork and literature research, represent essential steps for the in-depth study of the Mongue peninsula's landscape and, more specifically, the Mongue settlement's built environment. One of the final objectives is the definition of a masterplan involving the New and Old Catholic Mission areas and focusing on the adaptive reuse of the existing buildings, among which some colonial heritage spaces. Additionally, the solution provides ecotourism-related accommodation facilities within the New Mission, a kindergarten in the Old Mission, and a research centre between the two settlements and linked to the University of Maxixe (UP Maxixe) and the new Ecological Park.

The research involves peri-urban territories, focusing on their complex weakening and fragmentation processes, sometimes investigated together with environmental and hydraulic imbalances linked to waterlines. The aim is to identify possible reconnection strategies concerning the edge between urban and rural scenarios to be reimagined mainly through the architectural redefinition of open spaces and, sometimes, collective ground floors and, where present, the regeneration of water lines. An inclusive, resilient, and biodiverse connective fabric must extend beyond the edge space, involving peri-urban landscapes in their entirety and complexity. The critical reinterpretation of the Milanese area of the San Cristoforo disused railway yard and the design solution for Tor Bella Monaca in Rome, in addition to the investigated European case studies, represent two applications of analytical and design strategies matured during the research path.

Lavinia Dondi has been an adjunct professor at the School of Architecture Urban Planning Construction Engineering (AUC) of Politecnico di Milano since the **2016-2017** academic year and has conducted tutoring and teaching support activities, first at the School of Civil Architecture and then at the AUC School, since **2011-2012**.

Lavinia Dondi's academic publishing includes **2** authored book and **1** edited-by book, **10** book chapters, **7** journal papers, one of which is under peer-reviewed process and **5** of which are in "classe a"/Scopus-indexed journals, and **8** papers proceedings, one of which is upcoming and most of them subject to double-blind peer review. Since 2022 she has been a reviewer within the Editorial Team of the international scientific society Architecture Media Politics Society (AMPS).

The works testify to two research tracks. On the one hand, a track directly linked to the Ph.D. thesis and fueled mainly in the years after the dissertation: it deals with the neighborhood spaces for culture or social activities, focusing on the spatial ideas linked to inclusiveness, permeability towards the city, and interactions between uses. On the other hand, a more recent track deals with landscapes architecture and open spaces, involving territorial or design scales and urban, peri-urban or rural scenarios, investigated in their spatial proximity relationships, fragilities, and care perspectives connected to landscape design as a tool for knowledge, regeneration, and resilience.
